The AGC of East Tennessee's mission is to lead and improve the professional construction industry with Skill, Integrity and Responsibility. This mission led to the creation of **The AGC Scholarship of East Tennessee Scholarship**. This scholarship provides assistance to students pursuing a degree in construction or a construction-related program at a non-proprietary, technical, community or four-year college or university. If awarded, this scholarship will range from \$500-\$3,000 per academic year, depending on your course schedule, grades and other factors. The final determination of the award amount is at the sole discretion of the Community Foundation of Greater Chattanooga, Inc.

## **Requirements for the 2018-2019 AGC of East Tennessee Scholarship Program**

***In order to be considered for this scholarship, you MUST meet EACH eligibility requirement***

Applicant **MUST**:

- Attend a non-proprietary, technical, community or four-year college or university
- Must carry/complete at least nine (9) hours pursuing a degree in an construction or a construction related field (must carry at least three (3) credit hours of construction or construction related classes per semester)
- Have a 2.6 minimum grade point average to apply
- Be a U.S. citizen or an eligible non-citizen\*

### **Scholarship Requirements**

If you meet **each** of the above requirements, you are eligible to apply for the AGC of East Tennessee Scholarship. This is a **one academic year (Fall/Spring/Summer)** scholarship. Applicant is responsible for ensuring that **all** the following required documents are submitted in **one** packet.

1. Application must be completed in black or blue ink or typed and signed and mailed to the AGC office: AGC of East TN, 101 West 21<sup>st</sup> Street, Chattanooga, TN 37408
2. Submit your Fall 2018 class schedule
3. Submit your most recent official college/university transcript
4. Submit a copy of your 2018-2019 financial aid award letter
5. Applicants must be interviewed by the Education Committee before being considered for a scholarship.
6. If the proposed class schedule presented during the interview is modified, at the request of the student, the student will be ineligible for scholarship consideration for three (3) consecutive semesters.

***Late and/or incomplete application packets will not be considered (NO EXCEPTIONS).***

All required information must be submitted in its entirety by **Friday, June 29, 2018 by 4:00p.m. ET**

\*U.S. permanent resident, with a Permanent Resident Card (formerly known as an Alien Registration Receipt Card or "Green Card") Conditional permanent resident (I-551C), Other eligible noncitizen with an Arrival-Departure Record (I-94) from the Department of Homeland Security showing any one of the following designations: "Refugee," "Asylum Granted," "Indefinite Parole," "Humanitarian Parole," or "Cuban-Haitian Entrant", A citizen of the Republic of Palau (PW), the Republic of the Marshall Islands (MH), or the Federated States of Micronesia (FM).

## **Selection Process**

Applications submitted timely will be reviewed by members of the AGC of East Tennessee Education Committee. Applicants will be invited for an interview with members of the Education Committee of AGC of East Tennessee. The Education Committee will base their recommendations to the AGC Board of Directors on the applicants' course of study relative to their degree, thoroughness of the application, academic standing, responses to the short answer essays, Education Committee recommendation and interview. The AGC of East Tennessee Board will make recommendations to the Community Foundation. **Final** scholarship decisions are made by the Community Foundation of Greater Chattanooga, Inc. This is a **competitive** process.

Membership in your school's AGC Student Chapter is encouraged, but your participation will **not** give you an advantage over other applicants.

All applicants will be notified of their scholarship results via U.S. postal mail or email from the Community Foundation. The scholarship award will be sent directly to the applicant's college or university for payment toward tuition and/or books in August and January with an award disbursement (spring disbursements are based on the applicant meeting the requirements of the scholarship-details below)

### **Applicant requirements to receive the Spring disbursements of the AGC of East Tennessee Scholarship for the 2018-2019 Academic Year**

The scholarship applicant is required to:

- Submit a copy of grades at the end of the fall and spring semesters
- Submit Spring and Summer, if applicable, schedule(s) which includes at least three (3) credit hours in construction or construction related field.
- Maintain at least a 2.6 minimum grade point average
- Carry and complete at least nine(9) hours each semester (3/4 student status)
- Must be in good standing in a construction-related college program
